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Foreword

The Hounslow Education Partnership (HEP), working with the Education Performance & Data Team in the local authority, agreed to take a borough wide approach to quantify the potential adverse impact of learning disruption during the Covid-19 pandemic and the subsequent catch up required throughout the 2020/21 school year and beyond. This was discussed with the Primary Lead Headteachers at their HEP meetings in June and September 2020, where the headteachers agreed that we should proceed with this project. All primary headteachers were invited to participate in the project in November 2020.

There was a positive response from many schools and 19 primary schools provided their data for the project, giving us a good sample size on which to base the analytical work. Data was collected from participating schools on the pupils' baseline assessments from early in the 2020 Autumn term. The data covered Reading, Writing and Maths. This data has enabled us to establish pupils' starting points in the 2020/21 school year.

The Education Performance & Data Team have matched the assessments to pupils' contextual information (e.g. FSM and SEND) and this has enabled us to identify if disadvantaged or vulnerable children have experienced greater learning disruption than other pupils. At the end of the school year, we will match them to their end of year assessments, enabling us to identify which pupils have overcome any learning disruption and if any are still falling behind the school's expectations. We will continue to track these pupils in subsequent school years.

Analysis of the Back on Track Years 2 to 6 cohort

We collected data from 19 primary schools with a total of 5,539 pupils in Years 2 to 6. The data provided included pupil details and teacher assessments of whether the pupil was at, below or above the expected standard at the start of the 2020/21 school year. The data presented below is based on the combined cohort of all pupils in Years 2 to 6. We have done this analysis to give us the largest possible sample that would give us the best possible indication of where pupils were at across the local authority. While we cannot assume that the baseline profile from 19 schools will give an entirely accurate estimate of where pupils are at across the whole primary phase, it is still a large enough sample to provide a good idea of the magnitude of the challenge faced by Hounslow primary schools as a result of the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic.

The analysis of outcomes split by individual school Year Group are displayed in pages 11 to 35 of this profile.

Overall

For Years 2 to 6, there is a significant difference in the percentage of pupils assessed as being at the expected standard or above compared to the levels recorded in the last set of Key Stage 2 formal tests and assessments in 2019. The largest variation in the percentage assessed to be at the expected standard or above between the 2019 Key Stage 2 assessments and this cohort is in Writing with 44 percentage points difference. In Maths the gap is 38 percentage points and Reading 28 percentage points.

If we consider Year 2 as an example, and extrapolate from the baseline assessments from the sample schools this suggests that we would need around 1,000 pupils to improve from below to at or above the expected standard in Reading, for Hounslow schools to be performing at the level they were in 2019. The equivalent numbers for Writing are around 1,200 and for Maths 1,150. These numbers equate to around one third of the Year Group. This picture is broadly similar across all five Year Groups and this illustrates the magnitude of the challenge.

Attendance

We matched the pupils in the sample to their attendance data from the Autumn Term 2020. There appears to be a correlation between attendance levels and pupils being assessed to be at the expected standard or above. Those with the lowest levels of attendance (Under 80%) in the Autumn 2020 Term have the lowest percentage of pupils assessed to be at the expected standard or above, although the number of pupils in this group is small compared to numbers in the other attendance bands. The percentage of pupils assessed as being at the expected standard or above increases as attendance increases.

Chart 1: Pupils assessed to be at the expected standard or above by Autumn term 2020 attendance band

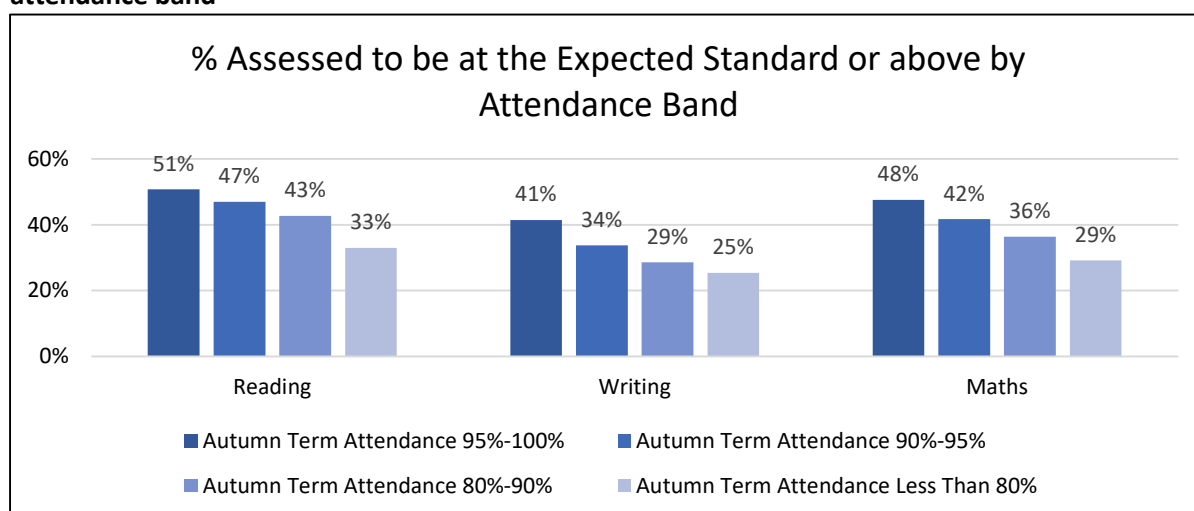

Gender

More female pupils were assessed as being at the expected standard or above than male pupils by a margin of around 10 percentage points in Reading and Writing and 1 percentage point in Maths. While the proportions of pupils being assessed to be at the expected standard or above are much lower in the sample population compared to actual performance in the 2019 Key Stage 2 tests and assessments the gender gaps are broadly in line with past performance.

Free School Meal (FSM) Eligibility

Of the pupils who are eligible for free school meals only 30% were assessed to be at the expected standard or above in Writing, for Maths this was 34% and Reading 39%. The percentage of FSM eligible pupils in the cohort assessed to be at the expected standard or above was between 12 and 14 percentage points lower than those not eligible for free school meals. The data show that disadvantaged pupils have probably been even more adversely impacted educationally than their peers.

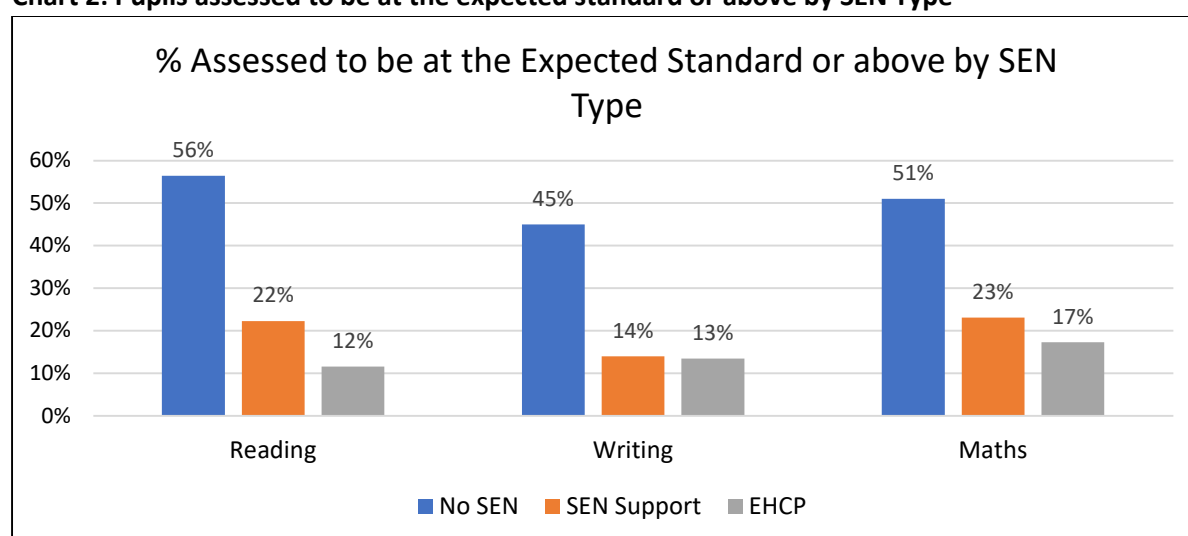

Fewer pupils with SEN Support or an EHCP were assessed as being at or above the expected standard. What we found when we compared this assessment data with previous Key Stage 2 outcomes in 2019 was that far fewer pupils with SEN support were at the expected standard or above, while pupils with an EHCP had assessments that were broadly in line with the previous Key Stage 2 outcomes for EHCP pupils in 2019.

The proportion of pupils with no SEN who were at or above the expected standard was higher than the overall sample cohort but was still much lower than their performance in the 2019 Key Stage 2 formal tests and assessments.

Chart 2: Pupils assessed to be at the expected standard or above by SEN Type**Ethnicity**

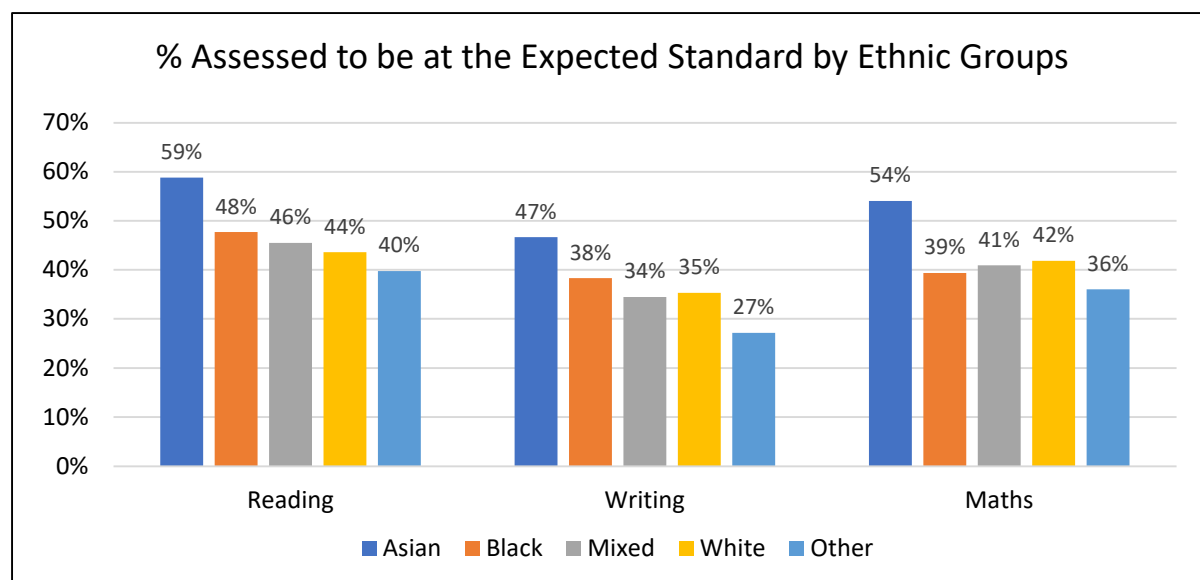
We have matched the pupils to their Main Category ethnic groups from the school census for this analysis. The Asian pupil group had a higher proportion of pupils assessed to be at the expected standard or above than the overall cohort. The proportions of pupils from the Black, Mixed and

White ethnic backgrounds assessed as being at the expected standard or above were in line or slightly below the level of the overall sample cohort. The proportion of pupils in the Other ethnic category assessed to be at the expected standard or above was between 9 and 11 percentage points below the overall sample cohort, across the three subjects.

Chart 3: Pupils assessed to be at the expected standard or above by Main Ethnic Category



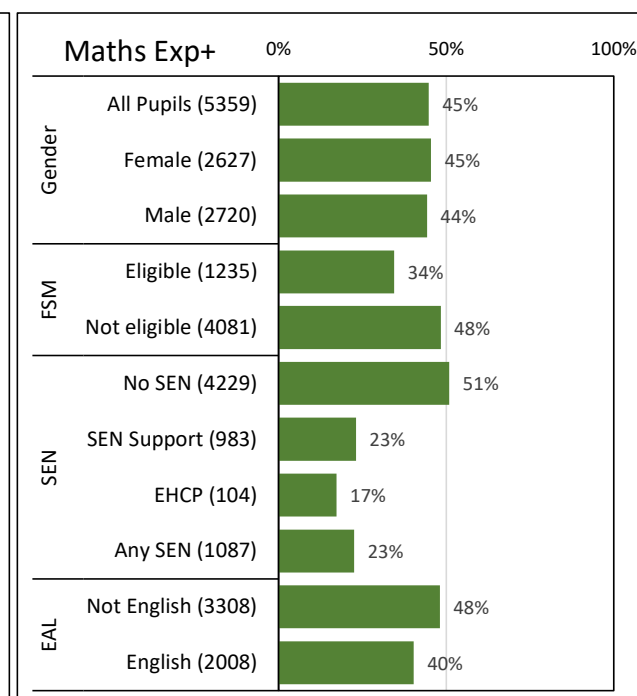
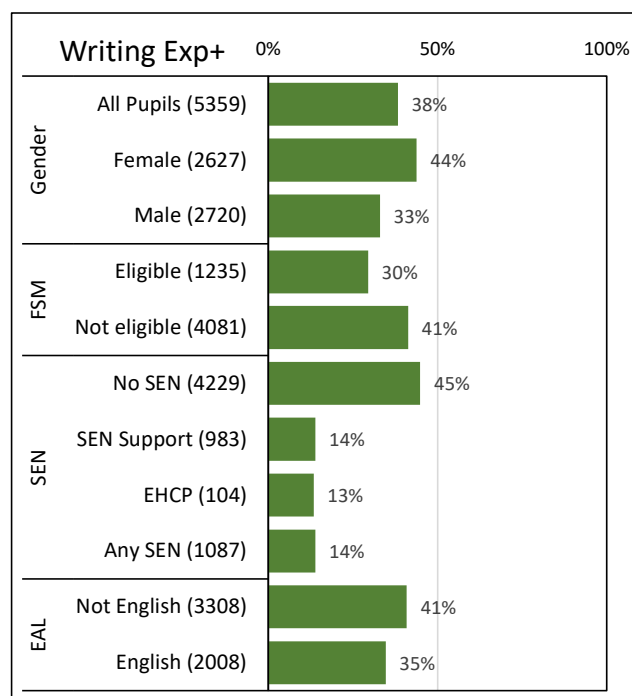
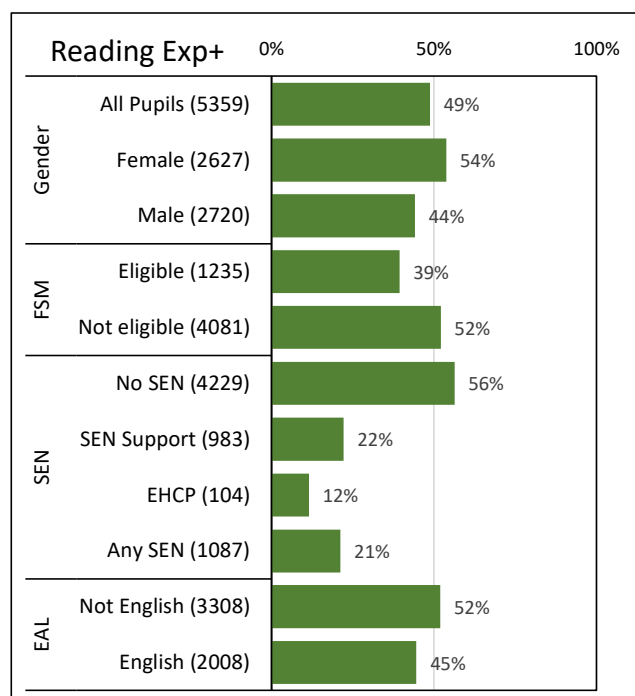
