If you are thinking of becoming a teacher, our school-led training course gives you the chance to learn through being embedded in one of our partner schools.

We offer a one year course for QTS with a PGCE (MA level) in partnership with the University of Roehampton.

You will be embedded in the classroom from the beginning of the program. This will enable you to start building the skills needed for QTS straight away.

WHY TRAIN WITH US?

Our schools are stimulating and diverse environments in which to train, where children, staff, and our trainee teachers feel valued and supported.

The LWA SCITT is distinctive in that its programme is led by highly experienced school practitioners who have also completed doctoral research in teacher development.

Our training routes are open to graduates with a first class or second class honours degree. We welcome applications from career changers and more recently graduates from universities.

We are particularly experienced in training suitably qualified teaching assistants or support staff already employed by a school wishing to become teachers.



HOW WILL IT WORK THE FIRST STEPS TO YOUR FUTURE IN TEACHING

You will be offered an induction programme to prepare you for your initial teacher training course.

Your training will take place on Wednesdays throughout the academic year in the SCITT. For the other four days you will be placed at one of our local partner schools.

You will attend staff meetings and development days as a full member of the teaching staff.

In your school you will be assigned a trained subject mentor and supervised by a professional co-ordinating mentor.

You will also be supported through visits from professional tutors from across the partnership.

In the first part of the spring term you will benefit from a contrastive teaching placement at one of our other partner schools.

All schools have comprehensive intakes and you will gain experience of working with young people of all abilities.

You will have access to post-16 year old learners in at least one of your placements.
