

Familial Child Sexual Abuse

In the UK we 'miss' most children who are sexually abused. We identify only 1 in 8 children at risk.

This applies to Hounslow and we want this to change. We have asked professionals what they need to help them to keep children safe and they told us they need training as a starting point.

We have developed a new course covering -

- Findings from Hounslow's Child Sexual Abuse audit
- What we know about numbers of children at risk
- What gets in the way of professionals protecting those children?
- Responding to children's help seeking behaviour
- The impact of sexual abuse
- Signs and indicators
- Who are the adults who sexually harm children?
- A model to understand sexually harmful adults and protect children
- The impact sexually harmful adults have had on professional practice
- Working with non-abusing parents/carers
- Consider dynamics of power in families

This training is appropriate for professionals whose work involves children and their parents and is **free** to Hounslow public sector organisations.

The course takes place over 2 consecutive half days. 9.00 - 1.00. Delegates must attend both half days. Delivery will be via Teams unless we are able to return to the classroom in which case it would take place at St John's Road. We will of course inform you nearer the time.
