WAYS INTO COMPOSING IN THE KEY STAGES 1, 2 AND 3 MUSIC CURRICULUM

Composing is often described as a ‘harder to teach’ aspect of the National Curriculum. This session will explore multiple practical ways into improvising and composing and what this might look and sound like across the different stages of education. It will use instruments, voices and technologies and introduce a range of materials to help teachers in primary and secondary schools to promote the creating and making of music across their own curriculum and school community. Participants will leave with a bank of ideas and an understanding of how composing can be progressively thread through the musical offer in your own school and unlock young people’s musical imagination and creativity.

Dr Alison Daubney is a qualified classroom and instrumental teacher and has taught all phases of music education from pre-school to postgraduate. She has worked as a teacher educator at three universities, including co-leading the Music PGCE at the University of Sussex for 12 years. Alison is on the board of her local music education hub SoundCity: Brighton and Hove, and works extensively with music organisations undertaking research and leading training. She has worked with the ISM on music education since 2008, co-authoring the influential APPG for Music Education State of the Nation report in 2019. Alison is the current co-editor of the British Journal of Music Education, author of Tea.
