

- Children's Commissioner reports young people and pornography, listening to the views of children and young people with SEND (Spring SHE term)





Diamond 9

Organise 9 ideas – great for prioritising, making judgements, exploring attitudes and negotiation skills.

Head heart hands

What might a character be thinking? feeling? What might they do? Great for empathy!

Helping pupils review statements; do they agree or disagree? Have their views changed overtime or based on the views of their peers?

Artefacts

Exploring real items (e.g. keeping clean) and considering how they're used, what they're for etc. Pupils answer a range of questions or complete a fact file about the items.












Which activities do you particularly enjoy doing with pupils?




